# THE RULES

## JUNIOR DEPARTMENT

1. No entry fee for Junior Competitors.
2. Prize money: To receive your prize money, you must fill out an entry tag for each entry and submit your entries on Assist Expo. A NEW number will be given to each new Junior Competitor. Please email [passecretary@hotmail.com](mailto:passecretary@hotmail.com) or text (905) 396-7709, for your number (provide child's name, birthday, and contact info). Prize money may be picked up by the exhibitor on Saturday and Sunday of the Fair at the Secretary's Desk in the red building.
3. All exhibits are to be taken to the red building. Exhibits will be accepted Thursday, Sept. 10th from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm or Friday, Sept. 11th from 8:30 am to 9:30 am. JUDGING BEGINS FRIDAY AT 10:00 am SHARP. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE IN BY 9:30 am to allow time for sorting. All exhibits are to remain there until 4 pm on Sunday.  
Please ensure your child's items are picked up by 4:30 pm Sunday. Work will be discarded after 5 pm.
4. All work must be done by the exhibitor. Parents are urged to allow the children to work and prepare the exhibit without assistance. Please encourage them in every way but allow them to do the work themselves.
5. Only one entry per person per section. Each entry will receive a ribbon.
6. All items to have been made in the current year and suitably labeled.
7. All baking to be covered with plastic bag or wrap and displayed on disposable plate. Ziploc preferred.
8. Use this year's theme – "*Blue Jeans & COUNTRY DREAMS*" wherever possible.
9. All judges are hired and paid by the Percy Agricultural Society.
10. Judges have the right to disqualify any entry they feel is beyond the age capability of the child.
11. Age of entrant is determined by age on opening day of the fair.
12. Age of participant must be recorded on tag for ALL specials to be judged in appropriate category.
13. Vegetables and flowers should be home grown except noted by an asterisk (\*).
14. Maximum size of entry should be 8 ½ x 11", unless otherwise stated.
15. Register online using Assist Expo. Details will be posted a minimum of 2 weeks before the fair.

Age must be indicated on front of the entry tag to be judged
