### Rules and Regulations:

- Cattle must be tattooed and have papers unless under 1 year of age.
- A cow/calf pair is "one animal". If you are going to split the calf that would be considered an additional "animal".
- Cattle must arrive before 9am unless communicated prior or be subject to disqualification.
- Exhibitors will be released following the completion of the Open Show Supreme Selections.
- Exhibitors must have proof of liability insurance to show on the grounds.
- **Pre- Registration Only.**
- **COVID Waiver must be completed for all participants prior to entry on the grounds the morning of the show. If waiver is not completed entry into the fairgrounds will not be allowed. Wristbands will be handed out and must be worn.**
- There will be no substitutions or additions after the entry deadline.
- Pee Wees and Junior Showmanship contestants must be pre-registered. No Day of entries.
- Junior Show confirmation entry must be registered in Open Show.
- CFIA Tags: Please be aware that all livestock must arrive with CFIA Tags, they are to be tagged before they leave the farm. Should they arrive without tags they are putting themselves at a risk for a fine. Animals will not be allowed entry to the fairgrounds if a tag has been found to be lost, or unattached. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the tag replaced prior to being allowed entry.
