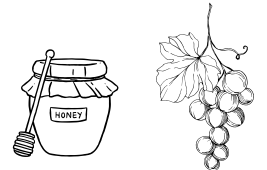

An increase of \$5/ticket due to increasing costs for the lottery licence, ticket printing, and the purchase of the vehicle.

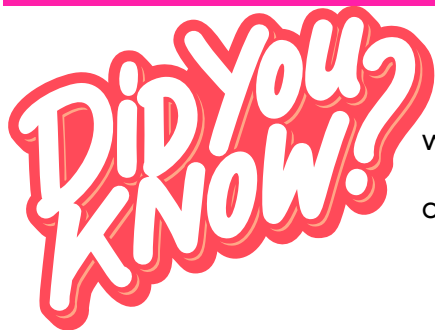
