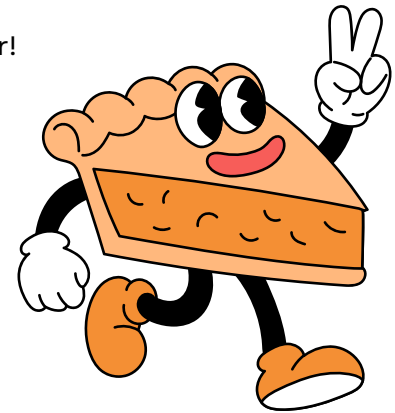
November Event Recap
