

Percy Agricultural Society - Facility Rental

The Warkworth Fairgrounds are located at 24 East St in the village of Warkworth and are privately owned and operated by the Percy Agricultural Society. It is home to the Warkworth Fall Fair as well as many other community events that are held annually.

The property consists of 12 acres of land situated within the town limits with access to municipal amenities. Our facilities include a fenced 190 x 105 ft horse show ring, enclosed horse pull track, tractor pull track, 40 x 60 ft heated Red Building & a large 55 x 160 ft rustic Cow Palace.

Amenities

Washrooms will be available at the canteen by the picnic shelter when construction is completed (may be seasonable). Presently a portable lieu is supplied during the summer months.

Electrical hookups are available throughout the fairgrounds and both the Red Building and Cow Palace have electricity. Access to a municipal water supply is available.

Additional items such as tents, tables and chairs are also available for rent.
