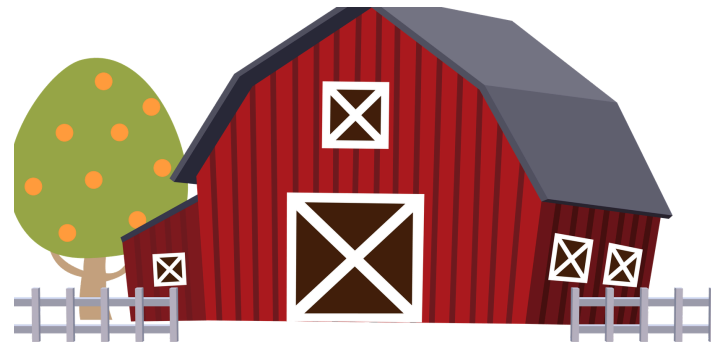

3 pm: Outdoor yard sale begins

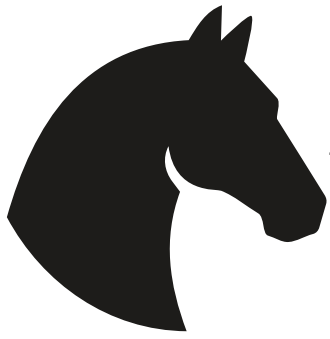

(adults \$10, kids 8 & under \$5)

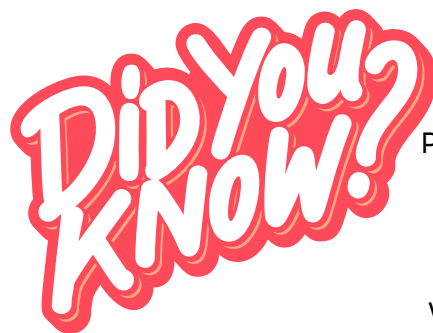
Saturday July 25th: Classic breakfast of sausage, bacon, hash browns, eggs & chili beans
