Competition Rules & Details

1. All entries must be dropped off Thursday, Sept. 9th, between 5 pm and 8 pm and Friday Sept. 10th, between 9 am to 11 am at the Red Barn on the Warkworth Fairgrounds.
2. No exhibitors will be allowed inside. Social distancing measures in place for drop offs.
3. **Each exhibitor will drop off entries in a box or tote, with their name in large letters on the outside of the box (for repacking and pick up purposes)**
4. Judging will take place on Friday, Sept. 10th
5. Entries are to be picked up Sunday, Sept. 12th, between 4 pm and 5 pm
6. Results will be posted on our Warkworth Fair Facebook page and our Warkworth Fair website www.warkworthfair.com between Friday, Sept. 10th to Sunday, Sept. 12th
7. One entry per person, per class
8. Everyone is welcome to exhibit.
9. All work on the entry must be completed by the exhibitor entering the competition.
10. Baking must be displayed on a disposable plate and covered with a sealed, clear plastic bag.
11. Judges may disqualify soiled and/or old exhibits.
12. Any exhibit, even though it may be the only entry in its section, will be awarded a prize only if it possesses sufficient merit as determined by the judge.
13. Exhibitors contravening any of the P.A.S. regulations shall forfeit all premiums to which they might otherwise be entitled at this competition. All special prizes offered on our Prize List shall be governed by the rules of the Percy Agricultural Society.
14. Prize money/coupon winnings will be available at pick up.

Rules

2. Entry must be made solely by the person entering the competition (including the pastry).
3. The size of the tarts must be full size tarts. (no mini or bite size tarts)
4. If the Fall District 3 2021 AGM cannot be held in person, judging will occur virtually, by photo. The Butter Tart Competition would not proceed, and we would move to judge 3 Decorated Cupcakes by photo. That decision would be communicated to all Ag societies in the District by September 1, 2021.
5. Each local fair is entitled to send three entries to the District Three Competition.
6. By entering a District Three Competition, the exhibitor agrees to allow their name and exhibit to be part of any promotional activities related to the competition.
7. Exhibitor's name, mailing address and the fair represented must be clearly labelled and attached to each entry.
